VISA: The visa is to be obtained prior to arrival in the country.

CURRENCY: Rand (ZAR) is the local currency and it is divided into 100 cents. Coins come in denominations of 1c, 2c, 5c, 10c, 20c, 50c, R1, R2 and R5, and notes in denominations of R10, R20, R50, R100 and R200. (01 USD = ZAR 7.90)

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS: Johannesburg International Airport (JNB), Cape Town International Airport (CPT).

AIRLINES: South African Airways (SA) flies directly from Mumbai to Johannesburg four times a week.

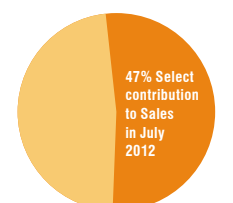
DAILING CODE: 00 27
